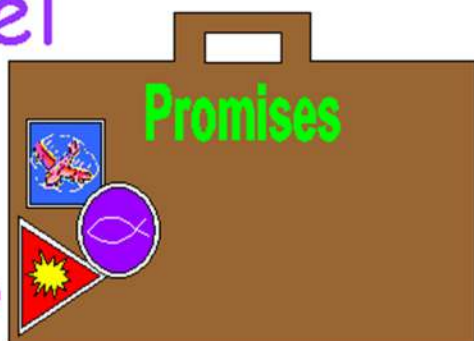

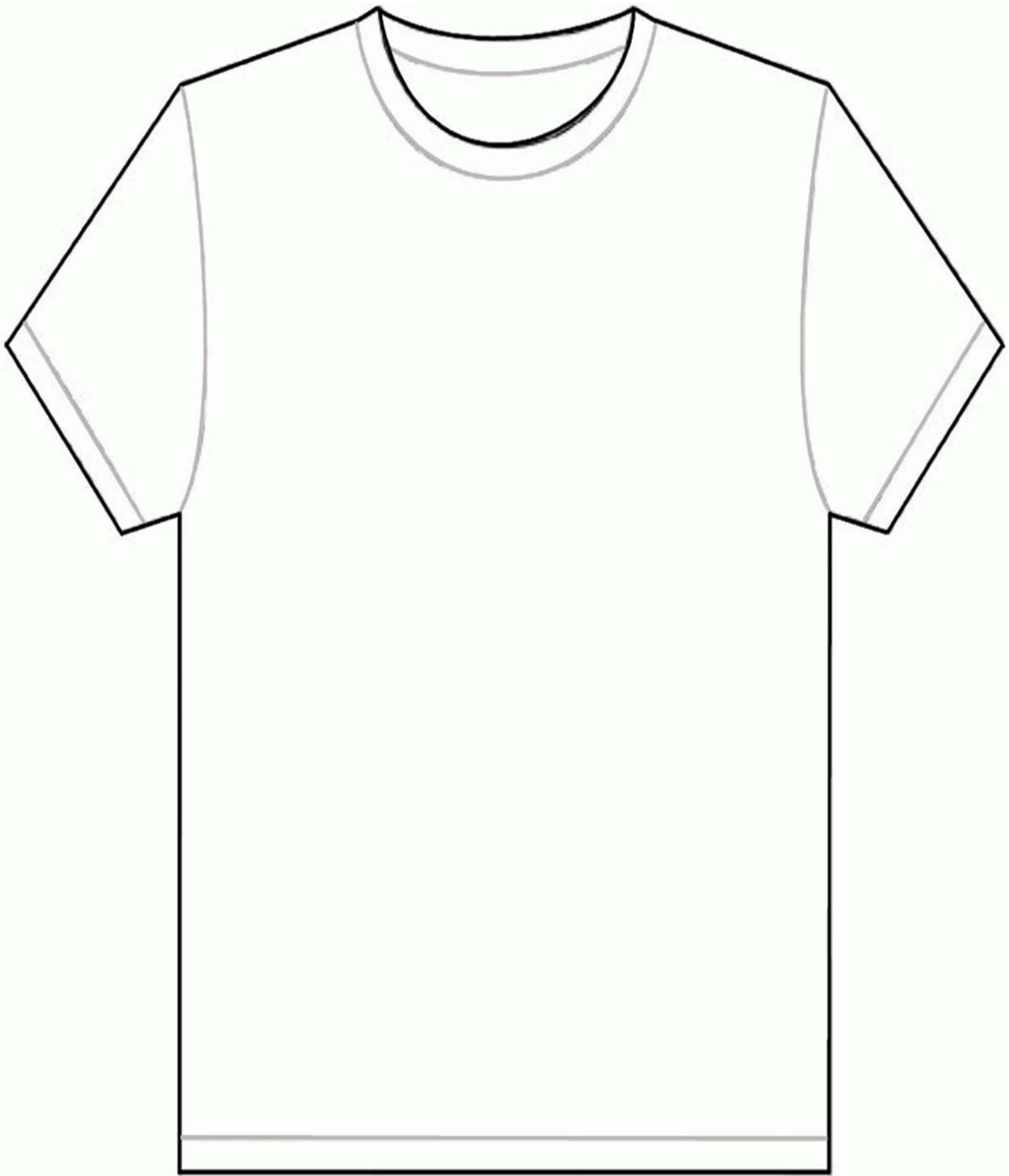

- Dress appropriately: Friday evening and Sunday morning – Type B uniform; Saturday evening – Type A.
- Rename your screen to show your child’s first name. Anyone who is not recognized as a registered participant will be removed from the Zoom session.
- There will be two breakout groups: Group 1 will include Little Lambs and Eager Beavers; and Group 2 will include all higher levels (Busy Bee, Sunbeam, Builder, and Help Hand). If you have Adventurer children who need to attend either groups, you may need to use a second device/computer to login to Zoom.
